POLICY: RESIDENT CLOTHING LIST

PURPOSE: As we strive to promote a home like environment, it is necessary to limit the amount of personal clothing in resident's rooms in order to maintain safe, clean, clutter free environment and to insure Infection Control Practices are being met consistently per State/Federal Regulations.

PROTOCOL:

1. On admission all clothing will be labeled.
2. All residents clothing must be machine washable and dryable.
3. Please consider the resident's personal tastes and comfort as you make these decisions.
4. When selecting clothing items, choose fabrics that will uphold in hottest temperatures to avoid shrinking.
5. No items that require hand washing and dry-cleaning (wool and angora, ect.)
6. No more than 10 items each of the following:
 - a. Pant / slacks
 - b. Shirt / blouses
 - c. socks / underwear
 - d. camisoles / t-shirts
 - e. Bras
7. No more than 6 items of the following:
 - a. Sweaters, pajamas or gowns.
8. No more than 2 of the following:
 - a. Robes, shoes, slippers, belts.
9. No more than 1 coat, hat, scarf and gloves.
